

THE AMERICAN LEGION JEFFERY S. HOLMES POST 84

April 4, 2024 MEETING MINUTES

The meeting convened at 1800 hours by Commander Dennis Brown.

Roll call by Sergeant-at-Arms Sam Zucker. Present were: Commander and Judge Advocate Dennis Brown, First Vice Commander and Historian Howard Bixby, Second Vice Commander Penny Johnson, Adjutant and Finance Officer Scott Holmes, Chaplain Luther Johnson and past commander, Charlie Patch. Visiting guest was Patti Holmes.

Meeting Minutes: Minutes of the December 7th, 2023 meeting was read by Adjutant Scott Holmes. Motion to accept by Sam Zucker and seconded by Penny Johnson. No discussion. Unanimously approved.

Finance Report:

- 1. Finance Officer Scott Holmes reported that we have \$11,247.78 in the bank. Since December the following has been paid: Boy Scout Luncheon \$75; \$50 fine for late tax filing; and baseball background check for Scott \$9.50.
- 2. The report was accepted and filed for audit.

3. The budget for 2024 was presented. A motion by Charlie Patch was made to accept the budget and seconded by Sam Zucker.

Service Report: None

Membership:

- 1. We have 39 paid up members for fiscal year 2023-24. Our goal is 40 members.
- 2. There is ongoing membership recruitment.
- 3. For the Department of Vermont 2024 membership standings as of April 4th, see Appendix A.
- 4. American Legion and Post membership is possible through national's web site. Individual Posts need to validate such memberships before applicant is accepted.

Americanism:

1. Howard Bixby announced that Flag retirement ceremonies will take place on June 15th at 10 AM.

Children and Youth:

- 1. The Vermont American Legion state scholarship fund is short \$3000.00. The Department has asked Vermont Posts for assistance with donations. Charlie Patch made a motion that we contribute \$100 of our education allotment. Seconded by Sam Zucker. Motion carried.
- 2. Charlie Patch reported that we will not have anyone representing the Boys State this year due to conflicting end

- of school year events. Girls state is still a possibility and he will let us know by the May meeting.
- 3. As stated previously, Scott Homes has completed the necessary background check required by the new rules of the American Legion Baseball. Coach Spencer has filed the necessary paperwork needed to register our team.

Old Business:

- 1. At the April Vet Council meeting, ceremonies for Memorial Day were announced as follows: the VA will hold their ceremony on Monday, May 27th at 10 AM; the local vet organizations will hold their veteran ceremonies on Thursday, May 30th in Hartford starting at 10:30 AM at the Maple Street Cemetery. Honoring Vets at the Villages will also be on this year's venue.
- 2. Commander Brown reminded us that we still need to plan for the American Legion Family Day in 2024. Discussion followed wherein the decision was made to have a BBQ at one of our baseball home games in July. Time and date to be announced when the baseball schedule is finalized in June

3. WWI/WWII Monument News

a. Commander Brown reported that the site prep work is being finished, including the electrical work, and will be ready by Monday, the 27th, for the 1 PM monument installation ceremonies. He also reported that the memorial bricks have been ordered and received by the Hartford DPW and waiting for the right weather for the mason to install. Mary Kay Brown has invited several people to attend and as

- asked a few to speak. The Main Street Museum will provide table and chairs.
- b. Discussion followed on whether we should have a color guard or will the Marine Corps League provide. Commander Brown will ascertain and let us know at the May meeting.
- c. Messrs. Briggs and Bartlett will provide Taps.

4. Blue Star Memorial

- a. Thanks to Mary Kay Brown we now have a permit application to legally work at this site.
- b. Discussion followed on whether Post 84 should adopt this site and maintain it. To be voted on at the May meeting.
- 5. Hometown Heroes Banners –Commander Brown, as the Committee Chair Person, made a presentation to the Hartford Selectboard. Results did not seem promising. Even though the Selectboard in 2023 allotted monies for this project, some members of the Selectboard feel more discussion is needed as to its purpose and impact on the Hartford citizenry.
- 6. Charlie Patch asked for permission to proceed with negotiations at the Montague Country Club for our September 21st golf fund raiser. A motion was made by Luther Johnson and seconded by Scott Holmes for him to proceed.
